1. Exhibitors are requested to file their entries as early as possible as this will save office work and will be to the advantage of both the exhibitor and association. The Association will close entries at 5PM on July 7, 2018 for all livestock entries. Mailed entries must have a July 7, 2018 postmark. After entries are made they will not be changed unless an error has been made by the office. The Association reserves the right to reject any entry not satisfactory to them. No entry fee will be refunded on changes made after 5PM on July 8, 2018.
2. Entry blanks specific to beef can be found on the fair website at www.clintoncofair.org.
3. No member of the Association or any officer of the Fair shall disclose to competitors or any other person, what entries have been made, nor shall any other person, other than the Secretary, superintendents and officers of the Fair, be allowed to know what other entries have been made before entries close.
4. Stall rent, entry fee, and exhibitor pass must be paid when entries are made.
5. Entry fee will not be refunded on entries that do not place.
6. Stall space will be assigned by superintendent.
7. Registration papers must be presented at time of entries. No photocopies will be accepted. All breeding stock must have registration papers, except for calves under 6 months of age; non-registered crossbreeds are not allowed in the breeding stock show.
8. Exhibitors will be limited to two entries in individual classes and one entry in group classes.
9. All animals must arrive by 8:00 pm on Wednesday, July 18, 2018. Weigh-in time for steers will be 8AM on Thursday, July 19.
10. Steer judging following 4-H show on Thursday, July 19, 2018 and Breeding Beef judging – 9AM on Friday July 20, 2018.
11. Animals will be released after 8AM, Saturday, July 21, 2018 at which time the premium checks will be ready for pick up.
12. EXHIBITORS must sign a receipt before receiving their premium check. Checks cannot be mailed.
13. All animals must comply with health regulations printed in front of the book.
14. All bulls over one year must be secured with a ring in their nose.
15. All animals shown in the Open and Junior Show must be entered under the same name and the property of the Junior showing them. (Same as registration papers)
16. Wood chips will NO longer be provided for bedding in barns.
17. Tie-out area will be marked.
18. Manure must be placed in storage bunkers. Trash must be placed in the receptacles. No trash placed in bunkers. No dumping of manure or trash between barns. Please help us keep trash out of manure bunkers.
19. The area between the barns must be kept open for fire and emergency vehicles.
20. All livestock trailers and exhibitor vehicles must be parked in the designated areas.
21. Open and Junior classes are open to all residents of Illinois.
