1. ENTRY FEE of \$16.00 per class and STALL RENT OF \$14.00 must be paid. PERSONS ONLY SHOWING IN THE BLACK AND WHITE SHOW MUST STILL PAY STALL RENT FOR EACH ANIMAL ON GROUNDS. Entry fee will not be refunded on entries that do not place.
2. Superintendent will assign all stall spaces.
3. Entry blanks specific to dairy can be found on the fair’s website. www.clintoncofair.org.
4. Exhibitors are requested to file their entries as early as possible. The Association will close entries at 5PM on July 7, 2018 for all livestock entries. Mailed entries must have a July 7, 2018 postmark. After entries are made they cannot be changed unless an error has been made by the Office. The Association reserves the right to reject any entry not satisfactory to them. No Entry Fees will be refunded on changes made after 5 PM on July 8, 2018.
5. No member of the Association or any officer of the Fair shall disclose to competitors or any other person, what entries have been made, nor shall any other person, other than the Secretary and officers of the Fair, be allowed to know what other entries have been made before entries close.
6. Registration papers on all animals must be available when you bring the animals to be judged. Papers will be checked. Registration papers MUST be available for copy when entries are made.
7. All dairy animals must be on the grounds 5:00 p.m. Saturday, July 14, 2018.
8. All animals must comply with the health regulations (printed elsewhere).
9. Judging of dairy will be Sunday, July 15 at 10:00 a.m.
10. Livestock will be released Tuesday, July 17, at 5:00 a.m. Exhibitors must sign a receipt before receiving their premium checks. Your signature on the receipt releases the association from any further obligation to pay premiums. If the exhibitor leaves the fair without collecting or providing for the collection of his/her premium, he/her cannot expect to be paid, as we need a signed receipt. Social Security Numbers required or no premium given. (per Illinois Dept. of Ag. Regulations)
11. No objects except straw in manure pile. All bottles, sacks, wire etc. shall be deposited in containers provided by the fair.
