**ENTRY FEE - \$10.00 per class • PEN RENT - \$5.00 per head • AMOUNT OFFERED - \$3,660.00**

1. Exhibitors are requested to file their entries as early as possible as this will save office work and will be to the advantage of both the exhibitor and association. The Association will close entries at 5PM on July 7, 2018 for all livestock entries. Mailed entries must have a July 7, 2018 postmark. After entries are made they will not be changed unless an error has been made by the Office, but the Association reserves the right to reject any entry not satisfactory to them. No Entry Fees will be refunded on changes made after 5 PM on July 8, 2018.
2. No member of the Association or any officer of the Fair shall disclose to competitors or any other person, what entries have been made, nor shall any other person, other than the Secretary and officers of the Fair, be allowed to know what other entries have been made before entries close.
3. ENTRY FEE of \$10.00 per class (single & group) must be paid at time of entries. Entry fee will not be refunded on entries that do not place.
4. PEN RENT of \$5.00 per head must be paid at time of entries
5. Each exhibitor must purchase an exhibitors pass for \$5.00.
6. All swine must be on grounds 12:01 am, Sunday, July 15, 2018.
7. Registration papers MUST be made available for copy when checking in.
8. All animals must be entered in the name of the true owner. See ownership rule page 6.
9. All livestock must comply with health regulations (printed elsewhere).
10. Judging of swine will be Tuesday, July 17, 2018 at 9:00 a.m.
11. Livestock will be released Tuesday, July 17, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. at which time premium checks will be ready for pick up. EXHIBITORS must sign a receipt before receiving their premium checks. Checks will not be mailed.
12. No objects except sawdust and wood chips in manure pile. All bottles, sacks, wire, etc. shall be deposited in containers provided by the fair.
13. Market Barrows and Gilts will be weighed on the fairgrounds on Sunday, July 15, at 7:00 p.m.
14. Market gilt cannot be shown in breed class.
15. Use separate Entry Forms for Class G and Class H.

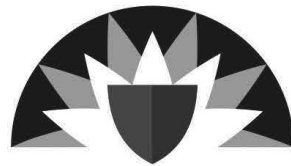
